2020-2021 GRANT FOR TEACHERS OF FRENCH

The Alliance Française of Hawai'i invites applications from current teachers of French interested in furthering their knowledge of the French language and Francophone culture.

Applicants must plan: to enroll in an accredited community college or university program or to attend professional workshops or conferences during the 2020-2021 academic school year.

Teachers must be currently teaching a French language and/or culture course and plan to use the grant to further their French language and culture studies to better their work in their classrooms. Eligible candidates will have demonstrated professional excellence and service to their French teaching profession and students.

The Scholarship Committee of the Alliance Française of Hawai'i will select recipients. Grant recipients must submit a brief report detailing how the funds were used and recipients may also be asked to attend one of the organization's functions to share with members how their funded studies help to promote the mission of the Alliance Française of Hawai'i. **The deadline for applications is March 01, 2021.** The funding amount and number of grants will be determined by the Scholarship Committee of the Alliance Française of Hawai'i after reviewing all applications. Previous grant awards have ranged from \$800-\$1000.
